159 companies / organizations in total, including 71 from Japan and 88 from Europe

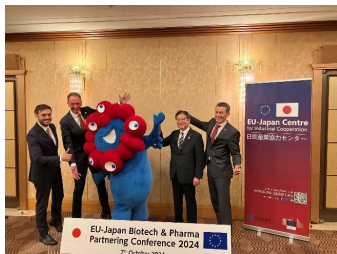

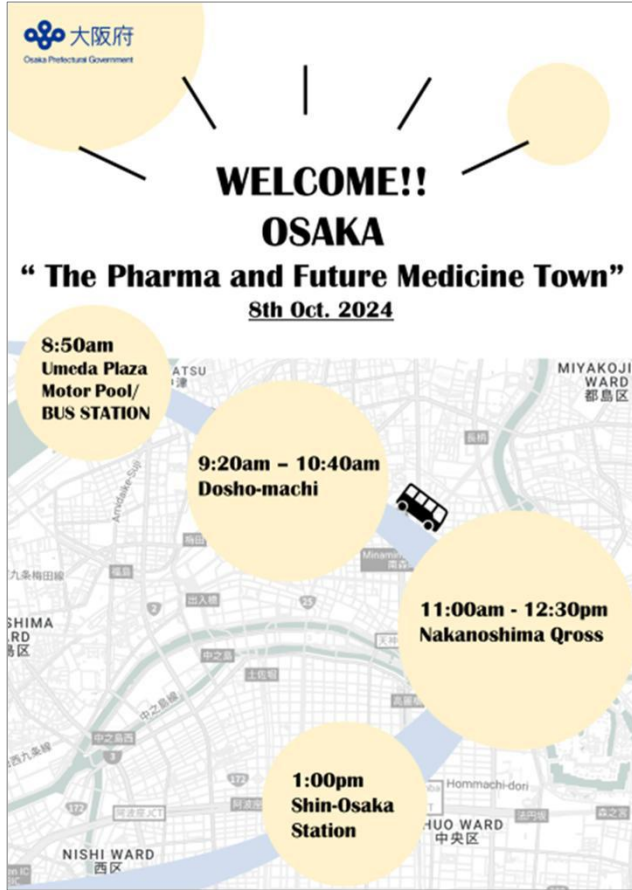

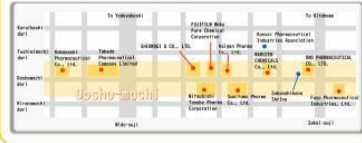

Dosho-machi

This street has long been home to a concentration of Osaka's major pharmaceutical companies including Takeda, Shionogi, Mitsubishi Tanabe Pharma, Sumitomo Pharma, and Ono Pharma. A walk around the museum of Mitsubishi Tanabe Pharma will give you a sense of Osaka as "the town of medicine". You can visit several corporate museums of pharmaceutical companies and a rare medicine shrine.



Nakanoshima Qross

It is a unique hub where has opened in June 2024 for the industrialization of future medicine, where medical institutions, companies, startups, support organizations, etc. come together under one roof.

- Hitachi Group's showroom, where visitors can experience the latest technology across the entire pharmaceutical and regenerative medicine value chain.
- CIRA Foundation, which will manufacture and stock quality-assured IPS cells and provide them to academic, research institutions and companies.
